PhD associated to the recently funded Project: THE WATERSCAPE AS A FRAMEWORK FOR SPECIES COEXISTENCE (WATERSCAPE) (REF PID2022-142083NB-C21). The project will aim to elucidate how phylogenetic relatedness is reflected in the coexistence patterns across different environmental gradients. The research is explicitly linked to theoretical ecology developments and aims to provide empirical evidence (observational and experimental) by considering physical and biological components of coexistence theory adjusted to specific field realities. Beyond traditional habitat partitions, the waterscape continuum template (spatially and temporally dynamic water on and within the upper layer of the Earth) will provide the framework for considering the dynamics of species-environment interactions.

→ PhD position in pollutants on pond biodiversity University of Vic, Barcelona, Spain



We are looking to hire a full-time pre-doctoral researcher for 3 years, which will be connected to PRISTIN research project (MINECO) to apply for UVic or Catalan or Spanish pre-doctoral funding. The project PRISTIN (Effect of pollutants on pond biodiversity across a climate and land use gradients) aims are to determine the effects of chemical pollution (pesticides and other OHCs) on pond biodiversity (phytoplankton, macrophytes, zooplankton, macroinvertebrates, amphibian and fish) and pond ecosystem functions and services (pond metabolism, GHG emissions, decomposition of organic matter, etc.), and to understand how climate change may alter the interrelationships between them. PRISTIN project started in September 2023 and lasts for 4 years.

We are looking for a candidate interested in the fields of stress ecology and ecotoxicology in freshwater ecosystems and trophic interactions between primary resources and freshwater macroinvertebrates. Your research work will be based on biochemical responses in freshwater macroinvertebrates and effects on community structure and function in freshwater ecosystems under multiple stressors scenarios (chemical pollutants and other anthropogenic and environmental stressors). The "Applied Ecology & Global Change" research area promotes the study of aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems, with an emphasis on assessing their response and resilience to different impacts related to global change. We apply a multidisciplinary approach including different taxonomical groups both in experimental and field studies. This research line aims to apply the knowledge on ecosystems functioning, and the respective services provided, as a basis for the design of nature-based and innovative solutions aiming the achievement of the global change impacts mitigation.
